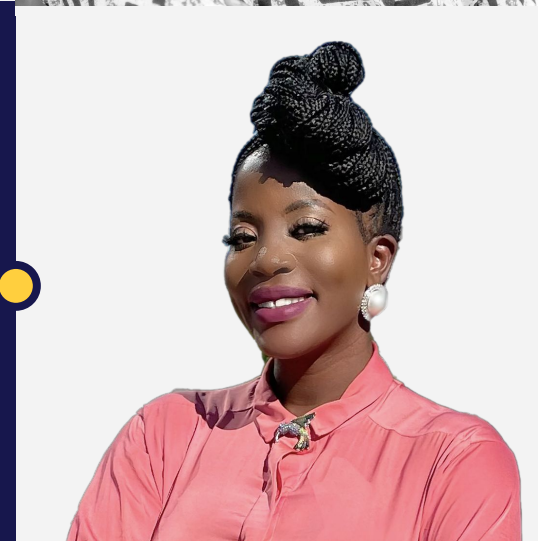

Worldcafes



Worldcafes are a method of knowledge sharing in an organic, interactive fashion. Mixed tables of participants work with moderators who guide the conversation through a series of questions, focusing on our transversal themes.

At the end, the facilitators will present the conversations focusing on key points:

- Projects or connections explored between participants
- Important issues or questions for AfriConEU to work on
- Challenges or opportunities to explore in Design Thinking Workshops

Networking
